BORROWING PROCEDURE IN LIGHT OF COVID-19

MCF is imposing changes in our borrowing process order to keep both our staff and borrowing missionaries safe during the current pandemic environment.

Effective immediately:

1. There will be a fourteen (14) day waiting period required between the missionary's arrival in the U. S. and the date MCF will loan a vehicle. In other words, the date a vehicle can be picked up from MCF must be no less than fourteen days after the borrowing missionary family has arrived in the U. S. for the current stateside assignment (furlough), UNLESS both drivers have a written negative test report dated not more than 14 days before arrival in the U. S. OR written evidence of complete vaccination prior to the desired date of vehicle pickup.
2. If the borrower has been experiencing a fever, coughing, and/or shortness of breath anytime in the past thirty days that must be discussed BEFORE the missionary arrives at the MCF office.
3. If the borrower has been tested for COVID-19 prior to picking up an MCF vehicle, either in the U. S. or in the country in which he/she has been serving, he/she must be able to show proof of the result of that test.
4. The borrower will need to bring with him/her a paper copy of his/her current U. S. driver's license and that of their spouse when they come to the MCF office.
5. We ask that ONLY one member of the borrowing family come into the MCF office to complete the required paperwork and pick up the MCF vehicle.

We regret that these measures must be invoked but there will be no exceptions to this policy until further notice has been issued by MCF.
