BORROWING PROCEDURE IN LIGHT OF COVID-19

MCF is making changes in our borrowing process in order to keep both our staff and borrowing missionaries safe during the current pandemic environment.

Effective immediately: A borrower of an MCF vehicle must produce, at the time of the pickup of the vehicle, either,

Proof of a negative PCR test that was done before the borrower left the country in which they were serving, or,

Proof of a negative PCR test taken within the past two weeks in the U.S.

This requirement will apply to both operators of the MCF vehicle.

Proof of vaccination will not suffice for the testing requirement.

Additionally,

If the borrower(s) or anyone in their immediate family has/have been experiencing a fever, coughing, and/or shortness of breath or other symptoms anytime in the past ten days that must be discussed BEFORE the missionary arrives at the MCF office.

With proper proof of testing and a negative response to the above condition the wearing of a mask in the MCF office is optional.

1. The borrower will need to bring with him/her a paper copy of his/her current U. S. driver's license and that of their spouse when they come to the MCF office.

2. We ask that ONLY ONE member of the borrowing family come into the MCF office to complete the required paperwork and pick up the MCF vehicle.

We regret that these measures must be invoked but there will be no exceptions to this policy until further notice has been issued by MCF.
